2024 Erie County Fair Junior Miss Qualifications, Pageant Rules & Information

• Qualifications:

- Female applicants must be 9-13 years of age as of January 1, 2024
- Must be an Erie County member of 4-H, Scouts, or Camp Fire Girls
- Must be exhibiting (individually or group) at the 2024 Erie County Fair
- Applications will be <u>available</u> on Saturday, June 1, 2024 on the Erie County Fair website (www.eriefair.com)
- Application <u>deadline</u> is Monday, July 1[,] 2024, no later than 11:59 p.m. (See submission directions on the "Important Application Information" sheet)
- Make sure you <u>thoroughly read through</u> the *"Important Application Information"* sheet
- Junior Miss Pageant will be held Thursday, August 8, 2024 at 7 p.m. in Building 1 on the fairgrounds
- There will be a <u>mandatory</u> meeting Sunday, July 28, 2024 at 6 p.m. A parent <u>must</u> accompany their child to this meeting. (I will be there at 5 pm. if anyone would like to come and <u>practice</u> walking on the stage.) We will be discussing interviews and pageant at this meeting and will be doing dress and short checks. Information will also be given on what to expect for the next year if your child is chosen to be a member of the 2024 Erie County Fair Royalty
- Interviews will be held Thursday, August 8, 2024 in Building 1 on the fairgrounds. Each contestant will participate in a 10 minute interview with the judges. Contestants are asked to arrive 15 minutes prior to their interview time. Contestants who may be showing during this interview time will be given first opportunity to sign up for interviews. (*Sign up for interviews will take place at the mandatory meeting.*)

PAGEANT

- The night of the pageant the girls will need to be there no later than 6 p.m. They are to meet me in Building 1 at that time. For the first part of the pageant, they will need to have knee length shorts or capris. I will allow blue jean shorts or capris this year but they must be knee length and look newer (meaning no holes, fading, or stains).
- For the second half of the pageant, they will change into their "dressy dresses" for the remainder of the pageant. Dresses should be age appropriate.
- Please bring dress and shorts to the mandatory meeting to get approval. (Dresses and shorts <u>must be approved</u> by the coordinators.)
- The girls will be escorted on stage by an adult male (father, grandfather, brother, friend, or role model – must be 18 years of age or older) during the second half of the pageant. I will need the name of their escort the night of the mandatory meeting.
- The judges will make their final decisions the night of the pageant.

This is a year long commitment with many parades, festivals, fairs, community events, and community service that the Royalty can choose to participate in.

IMPORTANT <u>APPLICATION</u> INFORMATION

- Make sure that your application is neat and your writing is legible.
 Remember if you are handwriting your answers, you are to only use blue or black ink. <u>No</u> pencil. Answers may also be typed.
- Your name needs to be printed on the top of every page
- You only need to submit pages 1-4 of application and any additional pages that you added
- You will need to include the following things with your application:
 - <u>Copy</u> of your birth certificate
 - Wallet-sized color <u>headshot</u> photo (this will be used for your application, pageant program, and possibly the newspaper)
- Applications are due on or before Monday, July 1, 2024. You will have until 11:59 p.m. to get your application to me.
