PAGEANT QUALIFICATIONS AND RULES

*New age requirement

In order to compete for the 2024 Erie County Fair King or Queen the following requirements must be met:

- **Member of Organization:** Contestant must be a member of one of the following Erie County Youth Organization: 4-H, FFA, Girl Scouts, Scouting America (formerly known as Boy Scouts), or Camp Fire
- *Age: Must be at least 16 years old by the night of the pageant (08/05/2024) and not older than 19 as of January 1st of 2024 (This is set per Ohio Fairs' Queen Contest rules.)
- **School:** Must be in high school, or have graduated from high school or completed GED
- Fair Exhibitor: All contestants <u>must be an exhibitor</u> (individual or group) at the 2024 Erie County Fair
- Not now or never have been married
- Not now or never have been pregnant or adoptive parent of a child.
- Not now or never have fathered a child or been an adoptive parent of a child
- No use or consumption of illegal controlled substances or alcohol
- Never have been convicted of a criminal offense or have criminal charges pending
- A <u>signed</u> Erie County Fair Royalty Rules and Regulations form will need to be signed by the contestant and parents and/or legal guardian(s). *This document must be turned in no later than the night of interviews (8/1/2024).* The contestant will not be eligible to interview or compete in the contest if the form is not in the hands of the Royalty Coordinator prior to your interview time.

- Ability to communicate
- Appearance and presentation

- 4-H and/or FFA involvement
- Fair involvement
- Community Service/Involvement

A <u>Mandatory</u> contestant and parent meeting (<u>at least one parent must attend</u>) for all contestants will be held on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>July 30</u>, <u>2024</u> at 6 p.m. (<u>Building 1 at the fairgrounds</u>). Complete details of the interview and pageant will be given and questions will be answered.

Interviews for all contestants will be held on Thursday, August 1, 2024 beginning at 6 p.m. (Building 1 at the fairgrounds). Professional attire or (ladies) a simple afternoon dress or (gentlemen) pullover shirt with collar and khaki or dress pants is suggested. Interview attire should be business-like.

PAGEANT:

The King & Queen pageant will be held during the Erie County Fair on **Monday**, **August 5th** at **8:00 p.m.** in **Building 1**. Please arrive ready to go on stage by 7:00 p.m.
